The Center of American Indian and Minority Health (CAIMH) continues to provide support and encouragement for American Indian students pursuing careers in health and medicine. CAIMH provides a comprehensive “pathway” of programs for students in kindergarten through medical school. Our programs include:

- Community Based Summer Science Camps (K-8)
- Stepping Stones to Health Careers Camp (Grades 9-10)
- High School Super Stars Program (Grades 11-12)
- Native Americans into Medicine Program (Undergraduate Students)
- Pre-Admission Workshop (Pre-Medical Students)

CAIMH also provides guidance and support for current University of Minnesota medical students including assistance with travel scholarships to conferences and workshops, such as the Association of American Physicians Cross Cultural Medicine Workshop and Annual Conference, book and study material loans, a learning resource center, a Seminars in Indian Health class, social gatherings & more!
